Radio Art Zone Finale

After 100 days of solid broadcasting by more than 200 renowned radio artists and a similar number of excellent kitchen radio chefs, Radio Art Zone will end this Sunday 25th September 2022 at midnight. As the largest celebration of radio art in the world, it has attracted over 250,000 listeners from more than 100 countries by now, making it the most widespread project internationally in the framework of the European Capital of Culture Esch2022.

The last weekend's highlights include 22-hour-long broadcasts from the anonymous collective <u>III [Shhhh]</u> this Friday and by the French radio artist <u>Julia Drouhin</u> on Saturday. For the Radio Art Zone Finale on Sunday the 25th September the legendary Japanese musician <u>Otomo Yoshihide</u> will perform a live concert in the Bridderhaus Apdikt in Esch-sur-Alzette starting at 21:00.

Over the coming weeks all 100 long-form radio art works created especially for Radio Art Zone will be made available as an online archive on <u>radioart.zone</u>. In 2023 a book will be published which takes the proceedings of these 100 days of unparalleled broadcasting as a starting point to illustrate the world of radio art.
